Billings Farm & Museum



A pleasant half-mile stroll from the Woodstock Inn, Billings Farm & Museum is an ideal way to experience the spirit of rural Vermont. Meet prize-winning Jersey dairy cows, draft horses, Southdown sheep, and heritage chickens and sample Billings Farm's own 100% raw-milk cheddar cheese. Explore the carefully-restored 1890 Farm House and learn about the farm operation a century ago. During the warmer months, wander the heirloom garden, apple orchard, and cornfields along the river, and unwind on the dairy bar terrace with a Vermont-made ice cream; a winter visit may feature horse-drawn sleigh rides through snowy farm fields. The daily afternoon milking begins at 3:30 p.m.! The museum features interactive programs, award-winning historical exhibits, and seasonal events. Admission to the Billings Farm & Museum is included for Woodstock Inn & Resort guests.

Orienteering



Orienteering is the sport of navigation, using a highly detailed map. Whether you are an experienced hiker, competitive runner, or just a family or group out for an activity in a park, this sport helps you improve your navigation each time. Orienteering can gradually build your map-reading skills from exploring a local city park full of obvious structures to navigating remote terrain with few, if any, man-made features.

For all participants, the structure of an event is a safety function. At the end of the event, the number of returnees needs to match the number who started, so always check in with the finish line volunteers, even if you do not complete your course. This keeps the sport safe and fun.

Orienteering events are timed. If you are a runner, running against the clock is a familiar experience, but orienteering provides added challenges of a staggered start and deciding where your own course goes as you are running. And if you are a non-runner, automatic timing from control to control provides a way to measure your navigational effectiveness across routes and compare later with others who made different choices. Good route choice often beats raw speed.

The Game at the Woodstock Inn

- Hosted by John Wiggin, former Navy SEAL & forester for Laurence Rockefeller.
- Guests need to be prepared to explore the outdoors- weather appropriate clothing (rain or shine!), hiking boots or sneakers.
- The group will be broken up into smaller groups of 6. Each team will be given a map. Teams will be briefed as a whole group- John will review the game and the rules. We run the Orienteering as Poker Orienteering- the group that comes in with the best hand of cards under the time, wins! (Client to provide prizes as they see fit).
- Briefing takes about 20 minutes and then the groups will be off and running. The game takes place through the village and lower slopes of Mt. Tom. The finish line is at the hotel.
- Scores will be tallied and the winners announced either at a post-game reception or by the group at a meeting or dinner later.
